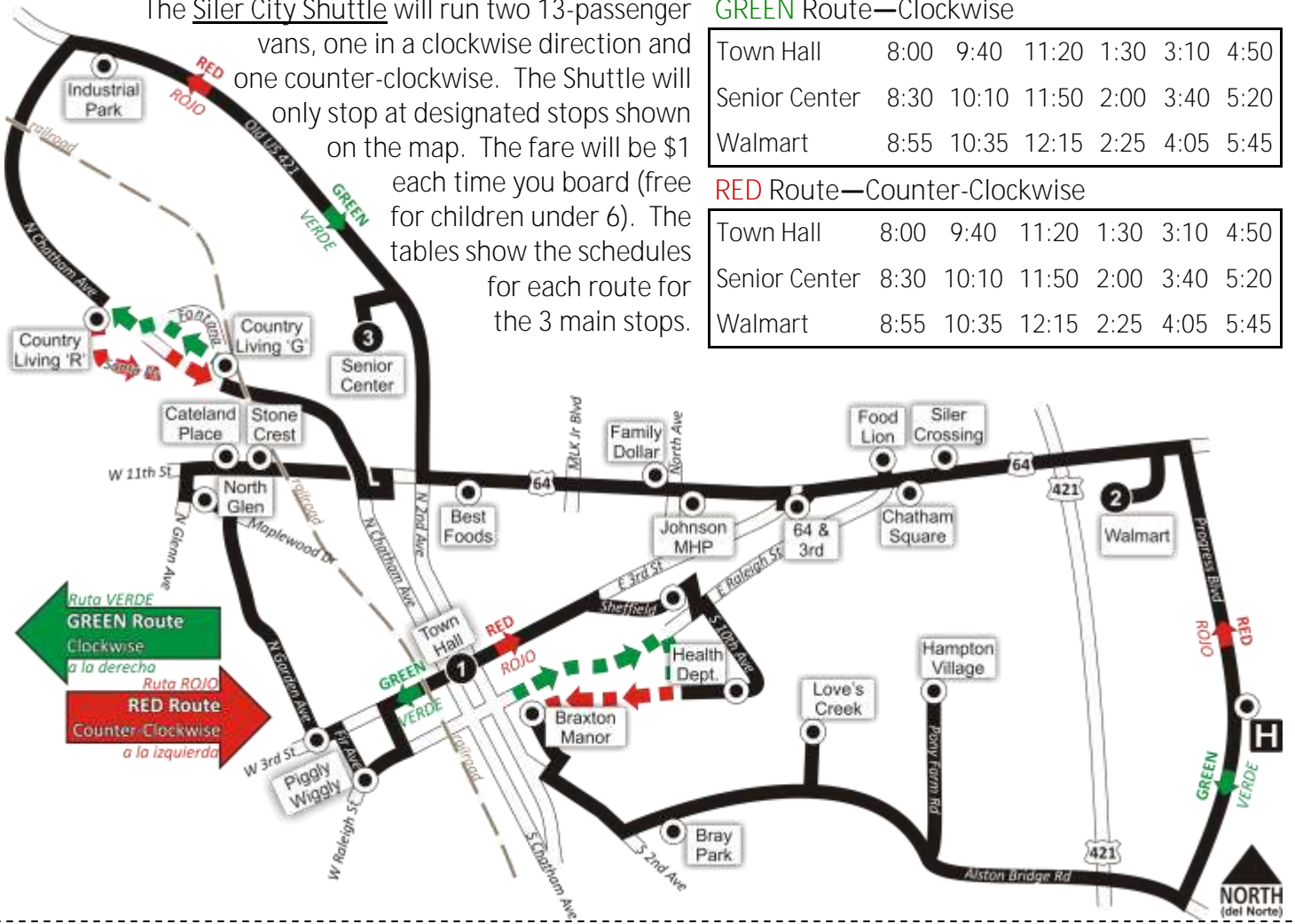
The Siler City Shuttle will run two 13-passenger vans, one in a clockwise direction and one counter-clockwise. The Shuttle will only stop at designated stops shown on the map. The fare will be \$1 each time you board (free for children under 6). The tables show the schedules for each route for the 3 main stops.
